## 5) Accumulated General Funds

It is the belief of the Trustees that the general reserve should be maintained at the equivalent of at least one years core expenditure. At 31 March 2020 the accumulated funds stood at £16,606 against regular expenditure of £26,588- thus the reserves are in line with the reserves policy and in the current climate are considered reasonable and not excessive.

## 6) Going Concern and the COVID-19 Pandemic

Given the level of reserves, the ongoing financial support of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames for 2020-21 and the continuing support of the membership via subscriptions coupled with a rental holiday on the office premises, the trustees are confident that Arts Richmond remains a going concern, despite the COVID-19 pandemic and the ensuing lockdown and the cancellation of many events in the first six months of the year, including the Affordable Art Tent and the Book Picnic associated with Richmond MayFair.
