We will be given guided tours at 12.30 and 12.45.

Sandycombe Lodge was built in 1813 to the designs of England's great landscape painter J.M.W. Turner working here as his own architect to create a quiet retreat for himself, away from the pressures of the London art world. He sold the house in 1826. It became a grade 2 listed building in the 1950s. In 2005 The Sandycombe Lodge Trust, now Turner's House Trust, was set up by Professor Livermore and on his death in 2010 the Trust became its owner.



Conservation was completed in the summer of 2017, with its brickwork beautifully restored, and all the results of careful conservation study and craftsmanship visible in the joinery, plasterwork and paint finishes.
